

What to Expect on Your First Visit

1. Finding Nurseries, Classes, and Services

When you enter in through the main entrance located on the East side of Building, there will be ushers to show you where to go. There is nursery for infants and toddlers and there are bible classes for all ages from Pre-Kindergarten to Adult.

2. What is the morning schedule?

Sunday School starts at 9:30 a.m. for children and adults alike. The children meet in the lower level and the adults meet upstairs in the Fellowship Room. Feel free to grab a coffee on you way upstairs. The Sunday Morning Worship Service begins at 10:30 am in Main hall. At that time there are nurseries provided for children 3 and under. Ages 4 to 12 can remain in the service to worship with the adults until they are dismissed to attend Junior Church.

3. What's on the schedule for adults, and what should I expect?

Teens through adults attend the worship service where they enjoy the music of the worship team, ensembles, and soloists. The music is always followed by a clear, helpful, and challenging Bible message from Pastor Wayne Melnechuk. This service is about one hour in length. Prior to the Worship Service are Adult Bible Classes. These classes are smaller group settings where you are invited to meet people, enjoy perhaps some refreshments, and hear a lesson taught out of the Bible. The best way to get to know people at Cheltenham Baptist Church is to visit the adult bible class.

4. Am I expected to participate in the offering?

No. We don't invite you to Cheltenham Baptist Church for your offering. We want our service to be a gift to you.
